Muslim travellers will generally find the following amenities in a [halal hotel in Istanbul](#):

- Halal food will be served to Muslim guests.
- The direction of Qibla will be mentioned in every room of the hotel, and prayer rugs will also be available and provided on request.
- There is a separate Prayer room/Masjid for males and females.
- There is a segregated Pool and Sauna for men and women.
- The Quran is available in every room.

Major Attractions in Istanbul

Muslim travellers should start their trip in Istanbul with the Prince Islands, where they will enjoy the sea and the sun in a peaceful environment. Muslim tourists should arrive at the Historical Peninsula after visiting the Prince Islands to sightsee monuments belonging to civilizations that settled in Istanbul in the past. The Grand Bazaar (widely known for jewellery, pottery, spice, leather, and carpet shops), Blue Mosque (dominating the skyline of Istanbul),

Hagia Sophia (an architectural beauty), Basilica Cistern (lying beneath the city of Istanbul), Topkapi Palace (containing important holy relics of the Muslim world), and Istanbul Archaeological Museums are pleasant venues for Muslim visitors for sightseeing.

Muslim tourists who travel to Istanbul should book a halal hotel close to famous attractions in Istanbul to enjoy most of the time visiting famous places in Istanbul. Muslim travellers must see a panoramic view of Istanbul from the Galata Tower.
