

How to Convert Moto G4 to Wireless Charging?

Motorola Moto G4 is another addition to Motorola's line of phones. The phone was announced in May 2016, and it was also released in the same month. It supports the following technologies: GSM (Global System for Mobile Communications), CDMA (Code-Division Multiple Access), HSPA (High-Speed Packet Access), and LTE (Long-Term Evolution). The phone is available in a plastic body and supports Single and Dual Micro SIM (Subscriber Identity Module). There are two questions that come to your mind before you buy the Motorola Moto G4, and they are: *Is **Moto G4 wireless charging** possible? How can you convert the Moto G4 to wireless charging?*

The answers to the preceding questions are affirmative. Moto G4 supports wireless charging, so you can convert Moto G4 to wireless charging. All you need to do is use a Universal Qi (energy flow) wireless charging receiver to wirelessly charge your Moto G4 smartphone. Moto G5 is an advanced version of Moto G4, so a question comes to mind, i.e., if Moto G4 supports wireless charging, then its advanced version should also support it. Moto G5 wireless charging is definitely possible.

How to Wirelessly Charge Your Moto G4 Smartphone?

In order to wirelessly charge your Moto G4, first of all, you need to remove your phone's back, then place your wireless charging receiver into the USB (Universal Serial Bus) port. There are two types of receivers for Moto G4 smartphones, i.e., wireless charging receivers with Type A and Type B ports. So, make sure you are using the right receiver for your smartphone. After placing the receiver on the phone's back, you should place the cover of your phone back. So, place the cover of your phone back. It is time to place your phone on the wireless charger with its face facing up. If the green light is lit, then it means your phone is wirelessly charging. The wireless charging receiver with Type A and Type B ports comes on the market for the price of \$12, and you can buy the receiver from an online store.

Qi Wireless Charging Equipment for Moto G4

Qi wireless charging equipment for Moto G4 is divided into two parts, which are the Qi wireless charging transmitter and Qi wireless charging receiver. Both of these things work together. If your phone does not have a Qi wireless charging transmitter, you should purchase one; otherwise, using the Qi wireless charging receiver is pointless.

Does Moto G4 Plus Support Wireless Charging?

Moto G4 Plus is a slightly advanced version of Moto G4, and it supports wireless charging.

This is all about how you can wirelessly charge your Moto G4 and Moto G5. The phones are great. Motorola has given the wireless charging option for the phone externally, so these phones look even better. Both Moto G4 and G5 support wireless charging, so it is not useless to think about the **Moto G4 wireless charging** adapter and a wireless charging case.

Many people have a question in their minds: *Why has Motorola offered wireless charging features in Moto G4 and G5 externally if some of the other smartphone companies have done completely the opposite?* Only Motorola knows the answer to this question.

Wrapping Up

Now, let's quickly go through what you have learned so far. Moto G4 and G5 are additions to Motorola's line of phones, and these phones support wireless charging externally. Further, Moto G4 and G5 wireless charging works with the assistance of a wireless charging receiver.
